#### Items accepted at NO charge:

Computers, laptops, monitors, routers, PDA's, cell phones, mice, keyboards, inkjet printer, toner cartridges, CD/DVD players, radios, televisions, network equipment, wires, stereo equipment, telephones, microwaves, small household appliances, and acid lead batteries including auto/marine and back-ups. Anything with a wire!

#### A \$10 disposal fee is charged for:

Wood-cased speakers, laser-jet printers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers and other coolant-containing devices.

#### Not accepted:

Light bulbs, single use batteries, smoke or carbon monoxide detectors, tapes/disks, glass, furniture, microwave plates, broken TV tubes or any hazardous materials such as paint or other chemicals.
