This past winter, as part of our online series, *"Who's My Neighbor?"* we got to meet Mayss and Amjad, a Muslim couple living and working here in Rhode Island who run an organization called AHOPE--"Americans Helping Others Prosper." Primarily, the work of AHOPE focuses on helping new refugee families who are coming to the U.S. to get settled. Often times, these families arrive on our shores with nothing but the clothes on their back, and little to their name. At a time of great unknown, AHOPE provides these families with food, friendship, and assistance in navigating their new life here in Rhode Island. Ultimately, the goal is to help families secure permanent housing.

At this time, our Missions Ministry is working alongside AHOPE to help provide needed items for new refugee families. These items include:

Bed sheet Sets (Twin or Queen size)
Towels

New or gently used:

Blankets
Pots & Pans
Small Microwaves
Small TVs
